Building Strong Home Groups: this workshop is meant to help NA members strengthen their home groups

Collaboration: collaboration is working together to achieve a common goal. We discuss and understand collaboration as an action principle and an integral part of our service system

Communication: our service structure depends on the integrity and effectiveness of our communications

Consensus Based Decision Making (CBDM): this workshop shows a cooperative process for making decisions in which everyone consents to the decisions of the group

Disruptive Behavior/Atmosphere of Recovery: this workshop is meant to help groups fulfill the responsibility of welcoming members without allowing an individual to threaten the safety of those attending a meeting
